

Annual Membership Terms & Conditions

1. By taking out an annual membership you accept these Membership Terms & Conditions of the Aldingbourne Trust when visiting the Aldingbourne Country Centre.
2. All members are required to have their photo taken on the first member visit to validate their membership card entry.
3. Photographs will be printed on the membership card for verification and authorisation. For each Individual Membership, the member's name will be printed on the card. For family memberships, at least one name must be printed on the membership card. Please note, at least one of the named members as printed must be present for the card to be valid for entry.
4. All members are entitled to unlimited entry during opening times at the Aldingbourne Country Centre.
5. Any accompanying non-member visitors will be required to pay the daily admission charge.
6. The membership is only valid when the annual membership fee has been paid and is 'in date' and presented by at least one of the named members printed on the card. Further validation checks may be required at entry.
7. Misuse of the membership card may result in the membership being withdrawn. No refund will be made in the case of misuse.
8. Membership is non-transferable and cannot be sold or given away to a third party. Membership is non-refundable.
9. You must show the membership card at the entrance each time you visit the Aldingbourne Country Centre. You may be asked to show your membership card on request whilst visiting the Centre.
10. Members under 16, whether as part of a family group, an individual member or as a day visitor, must be accompanied by a responsible paying adult and supervised at all times.
11. Photocopies of membership cards will not be accepted.
12. All events and activities are subject to change without notice and no refund or compensation is paid should the Open Farm or other activities close due to circumstances beyond our control or animal welfare.
13. All membership cards remain the property of the Aldingbourne Trust and can be withdrawn in the event of fraud or misuse. This includes, but is not limited to, allowing a third party to attempt to gain access with a Membership card of which they are not the valid holder.
14. Failure to present a valid membership card will result in the charge of the daily entry fee.
15. Lost membership cards should be reported to the Aldingbourne Trust as soon as possible. A printing and administration fee of £5 will be payable for a replacement card.
16. All correspondence in connection with the membership will only be sent to the nominated lead adult member who is responsible for ensuring these Terms & Conditions. Please advise any changes in contact details as soon as possible.
17. Extra charges may apply for members over the Christmas period and for occasional special events - this will be clearly marked in advance on the Trust website.
18. We reserve the right to update or change these terms and conditions from time to time with one months' notice sent to all the members.
